



Mayor Pro Tem Nancy McFarlane To Be Inducted Into YWCA Academy Of Women
*MedPro Rx President Honored For Business Achievement,

RALEIGH, N.C. – MedPro Rx, Inc. McFarlane and this year's inductees were introduced to current Academy members, YWCA board members, community leaders and friends of the YWCA in advance of the Academy of Women Awards, the oldest and most prestigious awards program recognizing women for their service to the community.

McFarlane started MedPro Rx, an accredited specialty infusion pharmacy that provides infusion medications and services to clients with chronic illnesses, in Raleigh in 2002.
